North Private –Ann Cheng **GreenTRIP Program Director, TransFORM** participated in the August 2019 meeting in San Diego. 4. Rural/Ex-Urban Setting -- Regardless of size, communities with widely dispersed development pattern; may have an agricultural, extraction or tourist-based economy. Examples: Truckee, Barstow and Yucca Valley
